The Sheriff's Office has been notified of our concern due to the increasing problems related to private property being destroyed over the past couple of months. Including one of our neighbor's dog being brutally murdered and another hit by a speeding ATV.

This past Saturday evening there were a group of teens roaming the neighborhood making a ruckus. Several folks commented with two parties going on they assumed their neighbor's "guests" wouldn't be destructive. We now know otherwise...

With this Saturday being Halloween, we all need to be super vigilant to prevent the vandalism we experienced last year from reoccurring. Please keep your lights on and keep an eye out. If you see anything out of place, including groups of unsupervised teens just roaming around, call the Sheriff's office immediately as they know we are no longer giving the benefit of the doubt.


