I would be remiss if I did not mention, as I do every year, that nothing has changed since my letter to William McKercher in 2020 or the letters to you and Chris Wells in 2023 that you should have on file and are also available on the website.

After updating the EAP last year, I contacted the "new" Tate County EMA Director Jim Huestis and "new" District 1 Supervisor Leigh Ann Darby to provide a copy as well as informing them that Tate County EMA has **IGNORED ALL REQUESTS** and never "checked-in" on the dam even when we've had record-breaking rain falls, not to mention they have never completed the annual run-through drill as required by the Emergency Action Plan.

Not to my surprise, I never even received a courtesy of a response from either. I didn't even hear from either after last years EF-3 tornado on April 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2025 devastated portions of this subdivision.
